



I. Apple Computing News

A. Waiting for New Macs? Apple Just Shared Bad News

Apple has just given a strong indication that it will not be releasing any additional new Macs for the remainder of the year.



Apple's CFO Kevan Parekh dropped the hint during the company's earnings call on Thursday:

On Mac, keep in mind, we expect to face a very difficult compare against the M4 MacBook Pro, Mac mini, and iMac launches in the year-ago quarter.

Parekh essentially gave a heads up that Apple's Mac revenue in the fourth quarter of 2025 might not grow significantly compared to the fourth quarter of 2024, likely because there will be fewer new Macs released this quarter than in the year-ago quarter.

In other words, he implicitly suggested that Apple has no further Mac releases planned for 2025.

Earlier this month, Apple updated the lowest-end 14-inch MacBook Pro with the M5 chip, but it did not release any MacBook Pro models with M5 Pro or M5 Max chips, and the Mac mini and iMac did not receive any hardware updates.

AppleInsider previously reported that MacBook Pro models with M5 Pro and M5 Max chips would launch in 2026, and Parekh's comment seems to support that. Mac mini and iMac models with M5 chips also appear to be slated for 2026, while the MacBook Air, Mac Studio, and Mac Pro were always rumored to be updated next year.

A lower-cost MacBook with an A18 Pro or A19 Pro chip is also rumored to launch in late 2025 or early 2026, but given Parekh's comment, early 2026 sounds more likely. This model is expected to be the spiritual successor to the MacBook Air with an M1 chip, which is still sold exclusively by Walmart for \$599 in the United States.

B. <u>Tim Cook provides</u> <u>update on next-gen Siri</u> <u>development</u>

During Apple's earnings call with investors yesterday, Apple CEO Tim Cook provided a (vague) update on Apple's work on the next-generation version of Siri. The Apple CEO assured investors that the company is "making good progress" on the more personalized version of Siri ahead of a launch "next year."

"We're also excited for a more personalized Siri. We're making good progress on it, and as we've shared, we expect to release it next year," Cook said.

This is essentially the same thing Cook said during Apple's earnings last quarter, but this time he did make sure to specifically call out the "next year" timeline. The continued confirmation that the features are on track to launch next year is reassuring. After all, Apple has

burned us on Siri timelines before.

Cook also took the time to tout all of the AI features Apple has shipped, including new ones this year like Workout Buddy for Apple Watch:

With Apple intelligence, we've introduced dozens of new features that are powerful, intuitive, private, and deeply integrated into the things people do every day. Features like Live Translation, which help users communicate across languages in real time, and Visual Intelligence, which opens new ways to learn about and explore the world.

We also introduced Workout Buddy, a new experience that uses AI to provide personalized, motivational insights based on a user's workout data and fitness history. And these join so many others from cleanup and photos and new image creation tools to powerful writing tools. We're also seeing developers take advantage of our on-device foundation models to create entirely new experiences for users around the world.

Cook's comments this quarter follow a Bloomberg report which said there are already "concerns from people testing iOS 26.4" inside Apple about the performance of the next-generation Siri.

As it stands now, Apple is reportedly aiming to release the new version of Siri as part of iOS 26.4. Whether or not that timeline shifts at all remains to be seen.

C. Apple Skips iOS 19– 25 and Jumps to iOS 26 — Here's Why is it called iOS 26

When Apple announced **iOS 26**, many users asked: Why skip from iOS 18 all the way to 26? Should You Update to iOS 26? Did Apple just forget about iOS 19 through iOS 25? Not exactly. Apple made a bold move by jumping straight from iOS 18 to iOS 26 — and it's left a lot of iPhone users scratching their heads. This version number leap wasn't random; it's part of a bigger shift in how Apple aligns its software platforms and branding. Here's the real reason behind the jump:

D. <u>Chipmaker TSMC</u> Reportedly Informs Apple of Further Price Hikes

Chipmaker TSMC has begun informing major clients like Apple about further price hikes, according to a new report out of Asia.



The leaker and aggregator known as "yeux1122" outlined the latest news on Korean social media site Naver. TSMC has apparently started notifying major clients of impending price increases for advanced fabrication processes below 5-nanometers. This would include Apple's A16, A17, A18, A19, M3, M4, and M5 chips, as well as any future iterations. The price hikes are expected to be in the range of 8–10% and commence next year.

Last month, the *China Times* reported that Apple's "A20" chip designed for next year's iPhone models could be considerably more expensive. The A20 chip is likely to be the first widely available 2-nanometer chip, debuting in the iPhone 18 lineup next year and forming the foundation of subsequent M6-series chips. The previous three generations of A-series chips have all been based on TMSC's 3-nanometer node, with the upgrade to 2-nanometer promising further performance and efficiency improvements.

TSMC apparently told customers, presumably including Apple, to expect pricing that is at least 50% higher than 3-nanometer processors. This was attributed to unusually high capital expenditure for the new node and to the lack of discounting strategies while yields are still in their early acceptable phase.

The report further stated that suppliers expect flagship mobile chips built on the 2-nanometer process to carry unit prices around \$280 once volume production begins. This would make it the most expensive component in the iPhone and dramatically affect Apple's profit margins, if the increase is not passed on to customers.

A report from *DigiTimes* last year placed the cost of the A18 chip at around \$45, with a total hardware bill of \$416 for a model that retailed at \$799, implying that the chip represents roughly 10% of bill of materials (BOM) cost and about 5–6% of retail price before logistics and development expenses.

If the component cost rumors are true, Apple could limit 2nanometer chips to only some 2026 iPhone models, such as the iPhone 18 Pro and iPhone 18 Pro Max. In September last year, Apple analyst Ming-Chi Kuo warned that "due to cost concerns, not all new iPhone 18 models may be equipped with a 2nanometer processor."

A. M4 vs. M5 iPad Pro Buyer's Guide: 20 Differences Compared

Apple's new iPad Pro comes almost 18 months after the previous version with the M4 chip, so how different is the new model and should you consider upgrading?



The iPad Pro introduced last year was a major update, debuting the M4 chip, a significantly thinner design, a nano-texture option, OLED displays, a landscape front-facing camera, and more, as well as a new Magic Keyboard with an aluminum top case, function keys, and a trackpad with haptic feedback. With such a big update last year, the new iPad Pro Apple just launched with the M5 chip is much more iterative, focusing largely on chips and connectivity. A new report from Mark Gurman at Bloomberg details some welcome display updates for some of Apple's most popular products. The iPad mini, iPad Air, and MacBook Air are all due to move from LCDs to OLEDs. Unfortunately, the changes could take a few years.

The iPad mini will move to OLED first, according to Gurman. That change may come as soon as 2026, and could include a price increase of about \$100.

The iPad Air will be next. It's due for an update in the spring next year, but that version will still use an LCD. The OLED update will come in the update after that, likely in 2027. Apple has no plans to move the base iPad model to OLED anytime soon.



In their early days, the iPad and MacBook were distinct devices that served completely different purposes. Recently, Apple began blurring the lines between the two, with the tablet gaining power-user features once exclusive to laptops.

The latest iPad Pro with the M5 chip marks another milestone in this transition, featuring upgraded

technology that allows more users to actually use it as a practical MacBook substitute. At this point, the iPad Pro is thinner, lighter, and more portable than a MacBook Air—and even surpasses it in performance and so many other aspects.

Performance: M5 power, with more Al

When buying a new computer, you typically look into its processing power first. You wouldn't want the operating system to lag or apps to crash while you get everyday work done. While, for good reason, one would assume a MacBook Air is more capable than a tablet, the latest iPad Pro just changed the game.

The new iPad Pro packs Apple's latest M5 chip, currently exclusive to it, the 14-inch MacBook Pro, and the second-gen Vision Pro. According to Apple, the 10-core CPU's multithreaded performance is up to 15 percent faster than that of its predecessor. Similarly, the M5's 10-core GPU's peak performance can surpass the M4's by up to 30 percent. That's not to mention the all-new Neural Accelerators

embedded in each core, which supercharge Alcentric, on-device workflows.

F. Why You Should Skip The M5 MacBook Pro And Wait For The M6 Model

The M5 MacBook Pro is expected to be released somewhere between late 2025 and early 2026. With minor upgrades in store for this model compared to the big M4 update from last year, there aren't many reasons to buy this yet-to-be-announced machine. While this MacBook is going to feature an outstanding display, Apple's industrial design with an improved Center Stage camera, and a more powerful chip, customers will have two options: Saving money and buying an M4 MacBook Pro or waiting for the M6 MacBook Pro, which is set to introduce a major revamp.

From our point it view, it seems like Apple is giving the M5 MacBook Pro the same treatment as the M2 — releasing it just a bit too late, only for a newer, better model to arrive less than a year after its debut. Here's why that might happen, and why you should think hard before upgrading to the M5 MacBook Pro:

Anticipation builds for the M6 MacBook Pro

The M6 MacBook Pro is expected to be the biggest redesign to the MacBook since the 2021 model, and there are many reasons to believe that will be the case. The most recent is a report out of Korea. According to dealsite.co.kr (via MacRumors), Samsung Display is readying new OLED panels for the MacBook Pro for a late 2026 release.

This report corroborates several others from The Elec, TrendForce, and beyond, all of which point to Apple planning to release its most exciting MacBook update in years in late 2026. Here are four reasons to skip the M5 model and wait for the M6:

OLED display: Currently, the M4 iPad Pro has the best display in an Apple product. That's expected to change when the company implements updated display technology in the M6 MacBook Pro.

Redesign: A previous report from Bloomberg suggests Apple wants to make a thinner MacBook Pro. Plus, with the new OLED display, the company could switch from the notch to a Dynamic Island-like cutout.

macOS 27: The 2026 software update will also be the first time that only Apple Silicon Macs can run the latest version of macOS. Apple will likely offer even better features, completely optimized for its custom chips.

5G support: Apple has been working on a Mac with cellular connectivity, and it seems the M6 MacBook Pro might be the first laptop from the company to offer support for its own 5G modems.

With all of that said, our take is that you can either get the M4 MacBook Pro at a discount in the near future, or wait for this one-of-a-kind machine to make its debut in the next year or two.

G. Forget the M5, Apple is reportedly already working on the M6 and M7

M5? I don't even know her.

Apple's M5 chip isn't even here yet, but we're already hearing rumors about the next generation and beyond.

In his latest report for Bloomberg, <u>Apple expert Mark Gurman</u> <u>indicates the company is already working on the next several</u> <u>generations</u> of <u>Apple silicon</u>, including the M6 and M7 chipsets.

Apple is expected to launch the first products using the M5 in the fall, with the MacBook Pro models getting the chip first this time around. The iPad Pro and MacBook Air models with the M5 are expected to hit the market in early 2026.

This means that the soonest we could see the M6 is likely Fall 2026. But what do we know about the M6 and M7 so far?

M6 and M7 are reportedly in development

What are Apple's "Komodo" chips?

Gurman's latest Apple report includes the codenames for upcoming Apple Silicon chipsets. The "Komodo" chips are expected to be the M6 generation, while the "Borneo" chips are likely the M7. Gurman also includes information on a future Apple chip codenamed "Sotra."

The upcoming M6 and M7 chips are designed to power upcoming Mac devices, including the MacBook Pro and MacBook Air models. And likely an iPad or two. The Apple M6 generation is expected to be the first Apple chips manufactured on TSMC's 2nm silicon wafer process node.

While we still expect the M6 and M7 to be powerful computing chips, Apple appears to focus more on AI for future chip generations. This makes perfect sense.

As more people use artificial intelligence, we start demanding more from it, leading to more complex AI models that require more powerful hardware. Since AI uses all three hardware accelerators (CPU, GPU, and NPU), it stands to reason that the M6 and M7 will be powerful all-around chips.

But that's not Apple's development team's only AI in the works.

Apple is also working on data center chips that will be used in the Apple Intelligence servers, replacing the current high-end Mac chips that run the Apple servers. These chips are part of the "Baltra" project and are expected to be finished by 2027.

H. <u>Apple Launching</u> Budget MacBook in 2026

Apple is developing a more affordable Mac notebook that's set to come out in the first half of 2026, according to *Bloomberg*. The machine will cost "well under \$1,000" and it will compete with affordable Windows machines and Chromebooks.



Apple's lowest priced Mac notebook right now is the MacBook Air, which starts at \$999, though students can get a \$100 discount through the Education Store. The Mac mini desktop machine is more affordable at \$599, but it is not portable and does not come with a display or peripherals.

While Apple has long had a more affordable "SE" version of the iPhone, Macs have always been more expensive, premium devices. Cheaper PCs have seen success with students and those that don't need capabilities beyond web browsing and document creation....

macOS 26 Tahoe: Summary

- The new version of macOS, called macOS 26 Tahoe, was released on September 15 2025. Some M3 Mac Studio users were encountering issues and unable to install the update, but the macOS 26.0.1 update has addressed this issue.
- macOS 26 Tahoe is also available in Developer and Public Betas. The macOS Tahoe beta program will continue even after the final release as Apple develops more features, implements bug fixes, and patches security holes. The current beta is macOS Tahoe 26.1.
- Tahoe will run on Macs released since 2019. It runs on all M-series Macs, but it runs on a small number of Intel-powered models. This will be the last macOS version to support Intel-powered Macs.
- With its new Liquid Glass interface, macOS 26 has its biggest design change since 2013.
- New features in macOS Tahoe include more options for personalization, improvements to Spotlight and Shortcuts app, and the introduction of a Phone app on the Mac and all the associated features.

Like its counterparts on the other Apple devices, macOS now has a brand new look along with a new name. Because Apple is aligning the names of all the operating systems this year, the new version of macOS is called macOS 26 rather than macOS 16. It also takes the name Tahoe, inspired by the lake, beaches, and the ski resorts of that area of California...





While the higher-end MacBooks with M1/M2/M3/M4 Pro and Max chips support multiple external displays, Apple's lower-end range of MacBooks that use a standard M1 and M2 processor cannot natively connect more than one external monitor, and to do so the M3 has to have its lid closed. This is a massive limitation compared to the previous Intel-based generation of Mac laptops that could run two displays when connected to a USB-C or Thunderbolt docking station or hub.

Apple's M3 MacBook Air models support two external monitors but only if the MacBook has its lid closed in what is known as Clamshell Mode. The M3 MacBook Pro supports a similar feature if at least the macOS Sonoma 14.6 update is installed. We explain how to run dual external displays on an M3 MacBook in a separate article.





Whether it's a mirror using the webcam to check yourself out for a team meeting, create a quick temporary tray of files to refer back to across apps, even drag to AirDrop files too, this does it all!

More features are coming soon, like being able to use the notch as a quick notetaker. But in its initial form, this is a great way to inject some unique usability into your MacBook.



The MacBook is a real champion of energy saving — there's a reason why the battery life is so good. But when you're doing more long-term tasks like uploading terabytes of data to a cloud drive, rendering a huge 4K video edit on Final Cut Pro, or any task where it would be more productive to leave it running while you do other things, those sleep features can prove problematic.

Amphetamine is the best (and free) way to tackle this. Not only can it override your Mac's sleep features, but you can trigger mode advanced automations too.

Launchy fixes that with a donut that opens immediately around the mouse cursor for you to switch between/open apps you're using. You can customize it, flick between wheels using arrow keys, and even set behavior controls to show certain sets of apps based on what app is open on the front.

It makes the whole app switching/mode switching so much more seamless, and has been a massive time saver of crucial seconds when working.

Why You Want to Stop iPhone Tracking & Listening

I believe everyone should take steps to control their digital footprint. By disabling these settings, you:

- Protect Your Data: Prevent audio recordings (like those from Siri dictation and optional handwashing features) from being sent to Apple.
- Limit Ad Targeting: Stop apps like Facebook and Amazon from tracking your activity across different websites and apps just to serve you "better" ads.
- Control Location: Restrict when and how apps, as well as your iPhone's system services, can track your exact significant locations and travel routes.
- Reclaim Privacy: Put up a strong wall between your personal life and the companies constantly collecting data on how you use your phone.

Q: Is my phone secretly recording my private conversations? A: While your iPhone is listening for the "Hey Siri" trigger phrase, most random ad pop-




